The Council of the League of Nations adopted on the 9th June the following resolution with regard to the Draft Convention on Slavery:

"(1) The Council decides to add the following question to the agenda of the Seventh Assembly:- Conclusion of an International Convention on Slavery and conditions analogous thereto".

"(2) The Council instructs the Secretary-General to suggest at once to all Members of the League that powers to sign the Convention which may be agreed upon be given to one of their delegates to this Assembly."

In execution of the second paragraph of this resolution, I have the honour to suggest that your Government give to one of its delegates to the Seventh Assembly powers to sign a Convention on the question of Slavery.

I have the honour to enclose the report adopted by the Council on this question together with a document containing the replies of those Governments which have sent in their views on the subject. I shall not fail to forward to you any further replies from Governments which may be received.
