The total number of supervision status excludes 4,000 absconders.

Detailed data are not provided for entries and Hispanic origin.

"Direct sentence" includes "split sentence."

Absconders continue under inactive supervision until located.

"Other" supervision status includes inactive due to incarceration for a separate offense.

"Other" exits includes other revocations (without incarceration) and administrative closures.

Offense type is estimated.

Data includes interstate compact cases supervised in Texas.

#### Utah

"Other" entries includes reinstated on probation.

"Other" exits consist of 11 court ordered release and 224 revoked and terminated.

# Vermont

Detailed data are estimated for race and Hispanic origin.

# Virginia

Detailed data are not provided for probation status.

"Other" entries includes restored to supervision, returned from States or district, transfers, and others.

"Other" exits include probation revoked, out-of-State terminations, warrant issued, transfers to other districts or States, and other.

# Washington
